Some Common Uses: The root is a blood-purifying preventative for colds and flu's, plus clears toxins that cause rheumatism, skin disorders, kidney stones and cystitis. Burdock root has been beneficial as a diaphoretic, antibiotic and for hepatic efficiency. Centuries ago it was used for boils, scurvy, diabetes, rheumatism, and as a "blood purifier".
